Program History

The Ithaca men's soccer team has made 17 postseason appearances in the last 23 years. The team reached new heights from 1995 to 1997, advancing to the NCAA quarterfinals each season. In 2008, Ithaca finished 10-5-2, raising the program's overall record to 498-323-80. In the 1990s, the Bombers were 130-56-22.

The winning tradition began under coach Isadore "Doe" Yavits. A member of both the Ithaca College and the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) athletic halls of fame, Yavits led the program from 1932 to 1962.

The team's success continued under Carlton "Carp" Wood, another Ithaca College Athletic Hall of Fame member, who took over in 1963. Two years later, Wood led the Bombers to their first unbeaten regular season and an inaugural trip to the NCAA playoffs. Ithaca lost, 2-1, to Brown, finishing 10-1-1. That year Ithaca Athletic Hall of Fame member Sandor Szabo set the school's single-season scoring record with 35 goals and eight assists for 78 points.

The Bombers were back in the playoffs again in 1979. Under coach Allan MacCormack, Ithaca posted an unbeaten Independent College Athletic Conference (ICAC) record and was ranked 10th in the nation. Kim Christianson, Bob Durocher, Bob Locke and Bob Thompson each earned first-team all-ICAC honors. The Bombers won a second straight ICAC title and received another NCAA playoff invitation in 1980. Bob Stiles scored nine game-winning goals that year, and Ithaca defeated Buffalo State in the opening round of the NCAA tournament before falling in overtime to Binghamton.

The hiring of current head coach Andy Byrne in 1984 has brought even more success. The Bombers made nine consecutive postseason appearances from 1985 to 1993. Byrne led Ithaca to a 12-5-1 record and an NCAA playoff bid in 1985, and was named the New York State coach of the year. In 1986 the Bombers captured the ECAC Upstate New York championship. Ithaca made NCAA appearances in 1987 and from 1989 to 1991. In 1989 the Bombers defeated Rochester, 2-0, in the first round before falling to RIT, 3-1, in the regional final. All-American midfielder Peter Lambert led Ithaca in scoring that season.

Goalkeeper Zac Shaw and forward Jason Dove were both all-Americans in 1991. Shaw had 31 shutouts and a 0.64 goals-against average, and Dove recorded 18 goals and 11 assists for 47 career points. Shaw was inducted into Ithaca's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998.

In 1995 Ithaca reached the NCAA quarter-finals and enjoyed a school-record 15-game unbeaten streak, led by forward Todd Stephan, who ranks third in career goals (43) and points (96), and goalkeeper Eric Pepper, who ranks second in career wins (38) and first in career saves (407). The next year, all-American Dan Katz helped the Bombers to within one win of the national championship game. In 1997 the Bombers reached the third round of the NCAA playoffs for the third year in a row. Forward Mitshel Lavander joined Katz on the all-America team. In 1999 the Bombers were again back in the NCAA playoffs,

qualifying for regional play. In 2002 Ithaca advanced to the second round of the NCAA tournament. Last season the Bombers finished with an 11-5-3 record, winning the Empire 8 regular season title for the fifth straight year. The Bombers were back in the NCAA Tournament and hosted a first-round game at Carp Wood Field, falling 1-0 in overtime to Johns Hopkins.

During the summer of 2003, 18 members of the Ithaca College men's soccer team traveled to Brazil for 12 days of soccer and sightseeing. The group visited Rio de Janeiro, Sao Paulo and San Jose.

The Bombers received training in Rio de Janeiro at the Zico Training Center from Julio Caesar and Andratti, two members of the 1994 Brazilian World Cup team, and in San Jose they received training from former Corinthians player Luis Fernando. They played matches with youth teams from Zico CT and Corinthians. They also had matches with the University of Maua and two amateur teams.

They visited Corcovado, Sugar Loaf and Maracana while in Rio de Janeiro. In Sao Paulo they visited the Corinthians' club and attended a professional soccer match. In San Jose, a smaller city of 60,000, the group spent more time immersed in the Brazilian culture getting to know the local people, especially at the soccer club.

Carp Wood Field



Since the 1989 season, the Ithaca College men's soccer program has played its home games at Carp Wood Field (formerly known as Upper Terrace Field). Before moving to Upper Terrace Field, the Bombers played at Allen Field. In 1988, construction forced Ithaca to play its regular-season home games at Cass Park in the city of Ithaca.

Upper Terrace Field was renamed during the summer of 2002 in honor of Carlton "Carp" Wood, a 1939 Ithaca graduate and charter member of the school's Athletic Hall of Fame who coached three sports at his alma mater. Wood led Ithaca to the NCAA playoffs in baseball, men's basketball and men's soccer, becoming the first NCAA coach to accomplish that feat.

Current renovations to the facility include construction of a press box as well the addition of a section of stadium-style seating.

Since moving from Allen Field, Ithaca has compiled a 103-30-12 (.51) record, beginning with a 2-0 win over Drew on September 2, 1989. The Bombers finished 7-2-0 at Upper Terrace Field that year.

Since 1980 the team has won over three-fourths of its home games, posting a record of 149-39-15 (.770). Ithaca is 5-4-0 in NCAA playoff games played at home. The Bombers beat Buffalo State, 2-0, and lost, 1-0, in overtime to Binghamton in 1980. In 1987 they beat Fredonia, 1-0, and lost, 2-0, to RIT. Two years later they topped Rochester, 2-0, and then in 1991 lost, 1-0, to Union. In 1996, they came back from a 2-1 deficit to score twice in the last 10 minutes and defeat Bethany, 3-2, advancing to the quarterfinals. In 2002 Bombers hosted Worcester State, winning 2-0 to advance to the second round. Johns Hopkins scored the only goal of the game in overtime of a 1-0 overtime win in 2008.

Ithaca also hosted the inaugural Empire 8 championship tournament in 2002, topping Elmira and Nazareth to win the title. The Bombers have hosted Empire 8 championship tournament games each of the past four years as well.

In Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) contests, Ithaca has compiled a 3-3 record at home. The Bombers hosted the ECAC tournament in 1986. They defeated Alfred (3-1), Hamilton (4-1) and New Jersey Tech (3-1) before losing to Middlebury, 1-0, in the championship.

Coaching Staff

ANDY BYRNE

Head Coach

Byrne enters his 26th year at Ithaca, where he's compiled a record of 269-124-41 and advanced to postseason play 17 times. He is the first Bomber men's soccer coach to reach 200 wins, achieving the milestone in 2002. His teams made nine consecutive playoff appearances from 1985 through 1993, with five of those berths in the NCAA tournament. The veteran coach guided the Bombers to three straight NCAA quarterfinal appearances (1995 to 1997) and a semifinal berth in 1996. Ithaca also made NCAA Tournament appearances in 2002 and 2008. Ithaca's winningest men's soccer coach, he was named the northeast region Division III coach of the year in 1996 and 1997.

A 1975 graduate of Plymouth State College, he played for Gerd Lutter, a member of the Ithaca College Athletic Hall of Fame. A team captain, Byrne earned four varsity letters. He later spent time as an assistant coach for Lutter with the Panthers before earning a master's degree at Eastern Illinois University.

Prior to taking the head coaching position at Ithaca, Byrne was the head men's soccer coach and a physical education instructor at Indiana State University-Evansville (now Southern Indiana). His teams won three consecutive Great Lakes Valley championships, posted a 34-18-2 overall mark and competed in the

1982 NCAA Division II playoffs. Byrne has also been head coach at the University of Massachusetts-Lowell.

Fernando Flaminio is entering his seventh season with the Ithaca coaching staff. A native of Brazil, Flaminio played goalkeeper for a number of professional soccer teams including Clube Fonte SP-Campinas in Campinas, Brazil, and Sao Paulo Futebol Clube in Sao Paulo, Brazil. His teams received division, state and national championship honors.

Flaminio received a technical accounting degree from Abdiel Cavalcanti Braga College in 1978 and a bachelor's degree in accounting and administrative sciences from Fundacao de Ensino Octavio Bastos in 1985. Along with speaking three languages he is also a level-three scuba diver.
